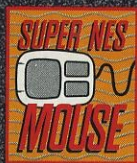

SECTION 1

SUPER NES MOUSE MANUAL

Thank you for purchasing the Super NES Mouse™, the unique mouse style controller developed for the Super Nintendo Entertainment System®. The Super NES Mouse provides new game play options and precise control when using the Super NES Mouse Game Paks.

To use the Super NES Mouse, you need:

- ① The Super Nintendo Entertainment System® Control Deck®
- ② Any Super NES Mouse Game Pak bearing the Official Nintendo Seal of Quality and the Super NES Mouse symbol.

NOTE: The Super NES Mouse will not work with the NES™ Control Deck.



Look for this symbol on other Game Paks specially designed for use with the Super NES Mouse.

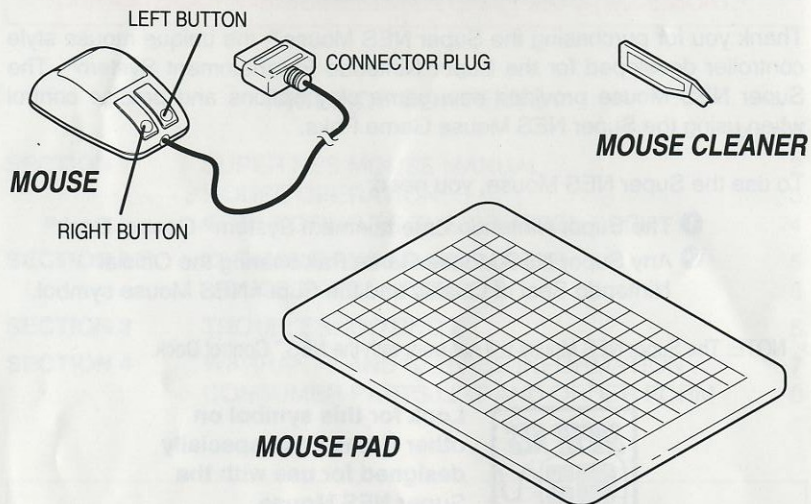

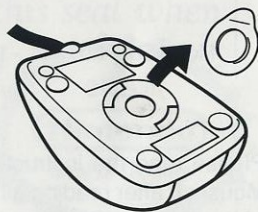

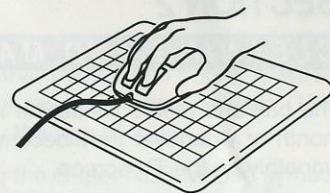
Before using the mouse, turn it over and remove the red plastic shipping cap covering the ball as shown.

NOTE: The red cap must be removed or the mouse will not function.

BUTTONS - The *left* and *right* buttons are used to "click" and select during game play. On each game, the buttons will have a different function or may not be used at all. Consult the instruction booklet for the Game Pak you are using.



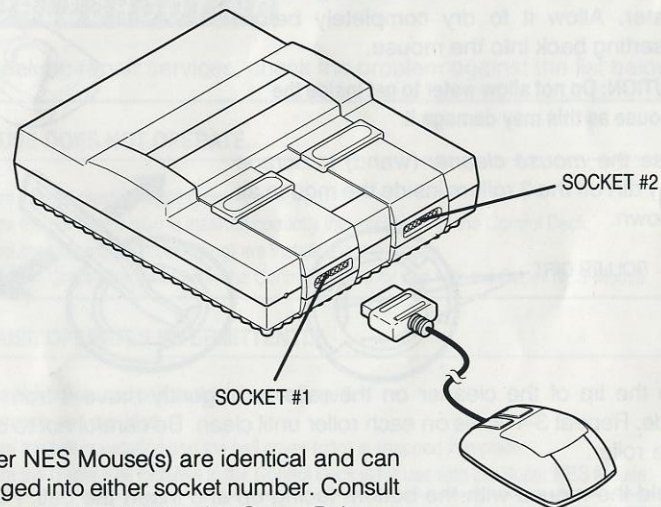
MOVEMENT - The mouse can be used on any clean flat surface such as a book or table but will work best with the *mouse pad* provided. Hold the mouse with the cord facing away from you and slide the mouse around the pad as shown. During game play, a cursor will follow your movements on the TV screen.



CAUTION: Do not use the mouse on a dirty or dusty surface such as a floor or carpet, as this may cause the mouse to malfunction.

CONNECTING TO THE CONTROL DECK

Plug the Super NES Mouse into the socket on the front of the Control Deck as shown.



All Super NES Mouse(s) are identical and can be plugged into either socket number. Consult the instruction booklet for the Game Pak you are using.

NOTE: Do not plug or unplug the mouse from the Control Deck during game play or while the power is on, as this may cause a game malfunction.

SECTION 2

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

The ball and rollers inside the mouse should be cleaned once or twice a month or whenever they become dirty or when the cursor does not move smoothly on the TV screen.

NOTE: Continued use of the mouse with a dirty ball and rollers may cause the mouse to malfunction.

- 1 Turn the mouse over, press and turn the ball cover (counterclockwise) as shown.
- 2 Remove the ball cover and flip the mouse back over allowing the ball to come out.

WARNING: KEEP THE MOUSE OUT OF REACH OF SMALL CHILDREN.

- 3 Clean the ball with a mild detergent and water. Allow it to dry completely before inserting back into the mouse.

CAUTION: Do not allow water to get inside the mouse as this may damage it.

- 4 Use the *mouse cleaner* (wand) to scrape any dirt off the 3 rollers inside the mouse as shown.



Place the tip of the cleaner on the roller and gently move it from side to side. Repeat 3-4 times on each roller until clean. Be careful not to damage the roller.

- 5 Hold the mouse with the bottom facing up and insert the ball. Place the ball cover over the hole and rotate it until it drops down, then continue rotating the cover (clockwise) until it clicks into place.
- 6 Clean the *mouse pad* with a soft, slightly damp cloth. Allow it to dry completely before using again. (Use water only.)

MOUSE PRECAUTIONS

- 1 The Super NES Mouse contains a ball that babies and young children could choke on. Keep the mouse out of reach of small children. This product is not intended for children under the age of 3.
- 2 Use the mouse with Game Paks bearing the Super NES Mouse symbol only. If the mouse is used with other types of Game Paks, they may not operate correctly.
- 3 The Super NES Mouse is for use with the Super Nintendo Entertainment System Control Deck only and will not work with personal computers, etc. Mouse controllers intended for use with personal computers will not work with the Super NES Control Deck.

SECTION 3

TROUBLESHOOTING

Before seeking repair services, check the problem against the list below:

PROBLEM

THE MOUSE DOES NOT OPERATE.

SOLUTION

- Make sure the red plastic shipping cap is removed.
- Make sure the connector plug is inserted correctly into socket #1 of the Control Deck.
- Make sure the ball and ball cover (ring) are installed in the mouse.
- Make sure the Game Pak installed in the Control Deck is for use with the Super NES Mouse.

PROBLEM

THE MOUSE OPERATES INTERMITTENTLY.

SOLUTION

- Clean the ball, rollers and pad as described on page 5.
- Use the mouse pad provided.
- Make sure the ball is installed and the ball cover (ring) is snapped into place.
- Make sure the Game Pak installed in the Control Deck is for use with the Super NES Mouse.

90-DAY LIMITED WARRANTY

90-DAY LIMITED WARRANTY

Nintendo of America Inc. ("Nintendo") warrants to the original purchaser that this product shall be free from defects in material and workmanship for a period of 90 days from the date of purchase. If a defect covered by this warranty occurs during this 90-day warranty period, Nintendo will repair or replace the defective product or component part, at its option, free of charge.

WARRANTY SERVICE OR REPAIR/SERVICE AFTER EXPIRATION OF WARRANTY

To receive this warranty service or to receive service after warranty expiration:
